Dear Mr. Claron!

Conforming with my promise given to you before your departure I will drop you a few lines. I suppose that you are well informed from other quarters about general things in Pittsburgh etc and will confine myself to matters regarding Pittsburgh Brew. Co. I am glad to say that we are in comfortable circumstances. Our bank Account is about \$200,000⁰⁰ and have about \$150,000⁰⁰ in Notes (received since our organization and old notes not figured in) in our safe. We do not owe anything except last month bills and will pay our quarterly dividend ^{on prof. stock} Monday a week. Figuring on profits per Bbl these summer months net us about \$1.75 p. Bbl. The sales for June & July were about 86,000 Bbls each month. July would have been considerable better but we had three weeks very cool weather. We have now yet \$181,000 Bonds 8,000 Shares prepared stock and all common stock received from the Syndicate. We have closed with Mr. Keesport Brew. Co. for \$325,000⁰⁰ and will pay for first days of coming week. I believe this is a good acquisition as the brewery sold 3500 Bbls in June and same amount in July. This brewery we will let own independent till at least May 1st.
