Minutes of meeting held at Concordia Club 45 St Apollo
An. Allegheny. Sunday July 21st at 9:30 AM. To
disburse money collected in the United States for the Benefit
of Johnstown Israelites.

The meeting was called to order by Mr Josiah Cohen in the Chair.
Following members present ^{Mr} Josiah Cohen, Kaufman, Adipman,
Enoch Rauh, Isaac Wertheimer, A. Fink, Meyer Joseph ~~and~~
Morris Kingsbacher ^{and} Mr de Wolf. In addition to this the
Johnstown Committee were also present namely L. M. Woolf,
Louis Cohen, Jacob Cohen ^{and} A. Cohen.

The report of Treasurer of fund was received and it
was found that \$11483.00 was in the treasury. It was
moved & seconded that \$11300 of this should be expended for
the sufferers and the balance \$183.00 should be turned over to
Mr A. Fink of the benevolent Society to be used in
future as emergencies may arise ~~from~~ our brethren in
the ill fated city. The Secretary of the Johnstown Committee
then read a report of the surviving Israelites at Johnstown.
The following amounts were then given to every surviving
head of the family. (Refer to letter book No 10 - Pages 675
and 676. This was done upon a motion passed
by the meeting authorizing the Treasurer to pay out the
