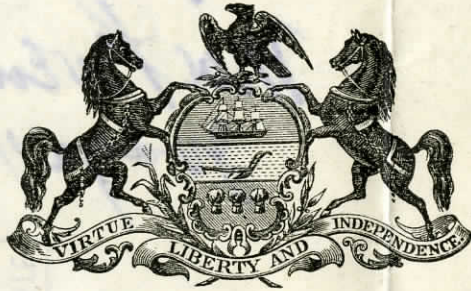

**Be it Remembered,** That at a Court of Quarter Sessions, held at the City of Pittsburgh, in and for the County of Allegheny, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the United States of America, on the Twentieth day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ~~ninety~~ Eighty-six, Adolph Edlis a native of Hungary exhibited a petition to be admitted to become a citizen of the United States. And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court, that he has re-

sided within the limits under the Jurisdiction of the United States for five years immediately preceding his application, and that during that time he had behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same, and that he had in all things fully complied with the laws of the United States in such case made and provided: and having declared on his solemn Oath before the said Court, that he would support the

CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES, and that he did absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the King of Hungary, of whom he was before a subject.

Whereupon the Court admitted the said Adolph Edlis,

to become a **Citizen of the United States,** and ordered all the proceedings aforesaid to be recorded by the Clerk of said Court, which was done accordingly.

**In Testimony Whereof,** I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the seal of the said Court at the City of Pittsburgh, this Second day of November Anno Domini, 1886, and of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America the one hundred and Thirteenth
