EXPLANATIONS

This report shows the pupil's monthly record in school room work and conduct, and is given out at the close of each school month during the term. The highest degree of excellence in scholarship and deportment is 100. A grade of from 90 to 100 is very good; 75 to 90 good; 75 is passing mark; 50 to 75, low; below 50, very low.

This report, when completed, will determine largely the pupil's claim to promotion.

Pupils Are Required:

- To be obedient and respectful to their teachers, regular and punctual in their attendance and civil in their intercourse with each other
- 2. To present a written excuse properly signed and dated by a parent or guardian for absence or tardiness; likewise a written request in every instance in which dismissal before the regular hour is desired.

Let the pupils remember that a good report can be secured only by regular attendance, good conduct and earnest work.

Parents and Guardians are Requested

- 1. To visit the school frequently.
- 2. Not to send a child with contagious diseases, as children thus afflicted will not be admitted.
 - 3. To furnish excuses for absence on all just occasions.
- Not to permit their children to leave home before the proper time.
- 5. To examine and sign the report each month and see that it is properly returned to teacher. If the marks received by the pupil are unsatisfactory, the parents or guardians are earnestly requested to communicate and co-operate with the teacher with a view to secure better results. Co-operation of parents is especially desirable when irregular attendance and low marks in conduct and application are reported.
