She became their representative in the Pittsburgh and surrounding areas, ~~and~~ <sup>as well as</sup> <sup>concentrated</sup> <sup>Hosp</sup> ~~and~~ <sup>later she</sup> ~~arranging~~ <sup>becoming</sup> for TB patients needing free non-sectarian services, becoming their Western Penna Director <sup>SERVING</sup> for almost thirty years.

In her retirement she <sup>wrote</sup> ~~who~~ many articles about her neighborhood and neighbors, which eventually became the basis of a book, entitled "Neighbors, You're Beautiful". The proceeds of the sale of the book were contributed to Hadassah.
