Dear Mrs. Anathan:

We are pleased to submit you our estimate on decorations at the Concordia Club for your daughters' wedding which is to take place March 27th, as follows:

**BALL ROOM.** We will bank the stage with tall Bamboos, large lacy Cibotium ferns and pandanus veitchi, with two Grecian stone jars filled with large white lilies.

Cut off the corners of the room either side of the stage with garden lattice decorated with Bamboos, tropical plants and trees of dogwood.

Furnish a platform 10 x 15 feet to elevate the bridal party. Either side of where the bridal party stands, will be tall floor standard candelabras with white candles.

Furnish a small round mahogany table with a silver wine cup for the ceremonial wine.

Festoon the walls and balcony with evergreen smilax.

From the background to where the bridal party enters, will be a wide runner of white crash and white satin ribbon held in place by ribbon standards to mark the bridal pathway, with lilies on the ribbon standards.

On the balcony we will arrange some tall Bamboos and Cibotium ferns. We will cut off under the balcony with garden lattice, tall Bamboos and Cibotium ferns.

The second floor hall to be decorated with tall Bamboos.

**FIRST FLOOR HALL.** Place large pandanus and ivy in jardiniere on the posts at the foot of the stairs.

Arrange some decorations at the fireplace of Bamboos and Cibotium ferns with sufficient number of Bamboos placed wherever most effective to break the bareness of the hall with a cluster of flowers on the mantel.

Place a background in the ladies room for the receiving party with a vase of flowers at one side. —

On the bridal table, at which are to be seated about thirty people, we will arrange sufficient number of low cupid Bohemian bowls placed on plate mirrors with cupid candelabras in between. These bowls to be filled with all white flowers. On this table we would like to use silver cloth fluffed up through the center. This will make a very beautiful table. —

Furnish a low crystal bowl of flowers with candles to match in separate colors on each of the tables where the guests are to be served.

All these decorations to be arranged as artistically as skill and experience can make it including all labor and material for the sum of Five Hundred and Thirty (~~\$550.00~~) Dollars.
