Be it Remembered, That at a Court of Quarter Sessions, held at the City of Pittsburgh, in and for the County of Alleghens in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the United States of America, on the LUCE LECT in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eightyday of DECCIVER HERMAN Overnand a native of HErmany exhibited and

admitted to become a Citizen of the United States. And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court, that he has resided within the limits under the Juisdiction of the United States for five years immediately preceding his application, and that during that time he had behaved as a man of good moral character, at ached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same, and that he had in all things fully complied with the laws of the United States, in such case made and provided; and having declared on his solemn Oath before the said Court, that he would support the, Sonstitution of the United States, and that he did absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, S tate, or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the ..... of whom he was before a subject. Whereupon the Court admitted the said Herman Obers whom he was before a Citizen of the United States, and ordered all

the proceedings aforesaid to be recorded by the Clerk of said Court, which was done accordingly. In Testimony Whereof, I
