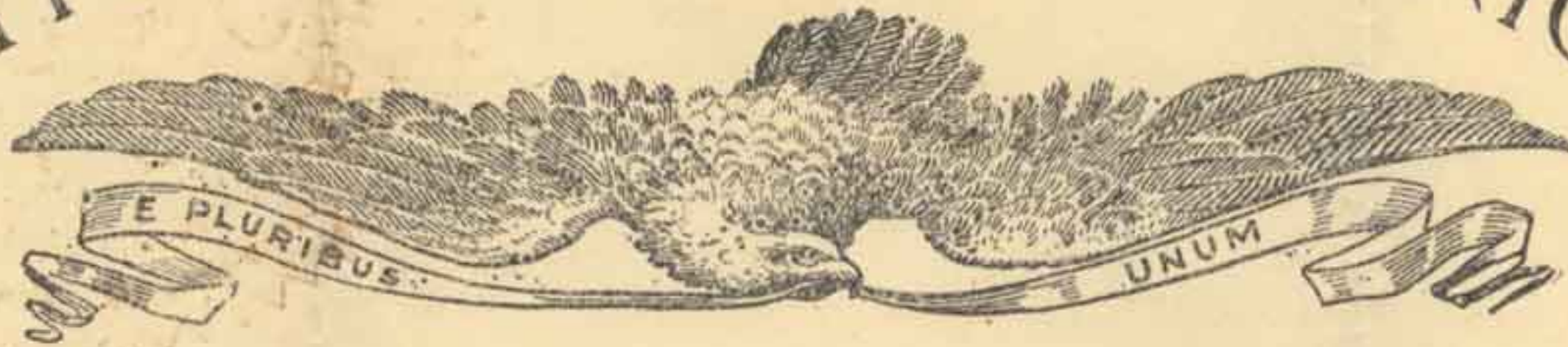


UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

Western District of Pennsylvania, ss.Be it Remembered,

That in the District Court of the United States of America in and for the Western District of Pennsylvania, at a session of said Court, holden at the City of Pittsburgh, in said District, on the second day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred one, before the Honorable Joseph Buffington, Judge of the said District Court of the United States, Abraham J. Sunstein a native of Russia came into Court praying to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America, and having, to the satisfaction of the Court, made the necessary proofs and complied with the requisitions prescribed by law, was allowed to take the usual oaths and make the usual renunciations, which he forthwith did, and he was thereupon ordered to be, and was admitted by the Court, a Citizen of the United States of America.
