Samuel Rosenberg: "By Light, Light"



Samuel Rosenberg is an artist's artist and an artist's teacher. Now in his 64th year, Samuel Rosenberg has exhibited continuously for more than 40 years and is one of the honored artists of our time. His list of one man and group shows covering the 40-year period is as striking a dossier as that possessed by any artist in our country. He is exhibited permanently in major museums, institutional collections and some of the finest private collections. Reference to his work is made in the most important books all the way from "Who's Who" to the Encyclopedia Britannica.

Artist Rosenberg has discovered the meaning of Light. Since light and shadow, color and shade determine what the eye sees — Samuel Rosenberg has experimented with "light" that he might translate what his mind's eye sees and put it onto canvas.

He builds structures out of blocks of light. He gets repose or action out of shading of colorings. His movement is a directional beam which might well be symbolized by an expression used in the old testament world: "By Light, Light."

Sam Rosenberg is the head of our Art Department and has been since its inception 35 years ago. The Isaac Seder Educational Center of the Y. M. & W. H. A. is proud of this union.
