The petition of the subscribers hereto, all of whom are citizens of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:-

That your petitioners have associated themselves together, with each other, and with the other members of the Congregation hereinafter named, which has been in existence as an ecclesiastical body since January 1, 1926, and desire for themselves and their associates, the members of said Congregation, the powers and immunities of a corporation, and in compliance with the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania entitled:- "An Act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain Corporations", approved April 29, 1874, and the several amendments thereof and the supplements thereto, do hereby certify the following to be the purposes, objects, articles and conditions of their said association:-

1. The name of the corporation is - "TEMPLE ISRAEL OF NEW CASTLE, PA."

2. The purpose of said corporation is to support the worship of God according to the faith, doctrines, rules, regulations, usages, canons, discipline and requirements of the Reform Synagogue of the Jewish Faith.

3. The business of said corporation is to be transacted in the City of New Castle, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania.

4. The corporation is to have perpetually existence.

6. The number of Trustees of the said Congregation is fixed at Five (5). At the annual meeting to be held in 1927 there shall be one member of the Board of Trustees elected for the term of three (3) years; two (2) members of the Board of Trustees elected for the term of two (2) years and two (2) members of the Board of Trustees elected for one (1) year. Thereafter the term of office of all Trustees (excepting those filling vacancies) shall be three (3) years, and until their successors are elected. Each of said Trustees shall be not less than Twenty-one (21) years of age, and a member of Temple Israel of New Castle, Pa.

7. The names and residences of the Trustees chosen by the existing organization for the first year, who are to serve until the annual meeting in 1927, are as follows:-

Until otherwise provided by the Congregation, the Trustees shall be elected by ballot by the members of the Congregation, not less than Twenty-one (21) years of age, at the annual meeting thereof.

Vacancies in the office of Trustee occurring in the interim between the annual meeting of the Congregation shall be filled by the remaining members of the Board of Trustees until the next regular annual meeting, at which meeting the vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired terms.

8. Said corporation has no capital stock nor shares of stock. The amount of real and personal property to be held by said corporation shall be limited to the amount authorized by law for such purposes.

9. Persons shall become members of said corporation as an ecclesiastical body and thereby members of said corporation, and shall cease to be members thereof, and thereby cease to be members of the corporation in the manner provided by the rules, regulations, usages, canons, discipline and requirements of the Reform Congregation of the Jewish Faith, insofar as the same are not inconsistent with the provisions of the Constitution and the Laws of the United States of America and of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the By-Laws of the said Congregation.

10. The property, real and personal, shall be taken and held subject to the control and disposition of the Trustees of said Congregation so far as the same are consistent with the Laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which control and disposition shall be exercised in accordance with and subject to the By-Laws of the said Congregation.

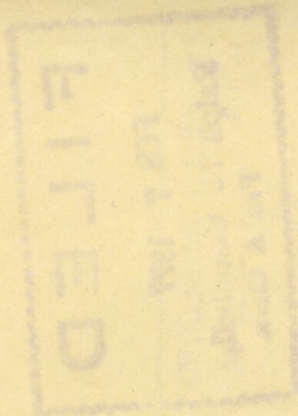
