The "Committee of Fifteen" is ready to make its first report to the Jewish community at large.

On Monday, May 13, 1957, two hundred and forty-three persons attended a meeting at the Community Center for the purpose of discussing a more United Jewish Community in Uniontown.

Almost 100% of those present accepted my plan to have a representative committee of 15 men explore the possibility of a merger of the Synagogue and Temple. Five men representin the Federation, five men representing the Synagogue and five men representing the Temple were charged with the responsibility of working out a plan of merger that might be acceptable to the membership of both religious institutions.

The "Committee of Fifteen", after a 42hour dinner-meeting held on May 28, 1957, is ready to report the first phase of their deliberations.

Therefore, you are cordially invited to attend a combined meeting of the Synagogue and Temple membership which will be held on WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12, at the Jewish Community Center, at 8:15 P.M. sharp.

Immediately after the report of the "committee of Fifteen" there will be an open discussion from the floor.
