O R D E R.

In the Court of Common Pleas of Fayette County,
In the matter of the incorporation of HOLY SOCIETY.-

And now, to wit, January 21, 1920, the within certificate of incorporation having been on file in the office of the Prothonotary of said Court since the 10th day of December, 1919, as appears from the entry thereon and due proof of said publication having been presented to me, I hereby certify that I have perused and examined said instrument and find the same to be in proper form, and within the specified purposes of corporations of the first class according to Par. 2 of the Act of April, 29th, 1874, and that the said purposes are lawful and not injurious to the community. It is therefore ordered and decreed that the same subject to the amendment thereof, be approved, and that upon the recording of the said Charter and its endorsements and the amendment of the name thereof and this order in the office of the recorder of deeds in and for said county, the subscribers thereto and their associates shall thenceforth be a corporation for the purposes and upon the terms and under the name therein stated, HOLY SOCIETY.
