Several families professing Liberal Judaism lived in Uniontown before 1850 butthis communion was not large enough to form a permanent congregation until 1904. Previous to that date these families held High Holy Day services under the leadership of students from the Hebrew Union College. On June 6, 1904, the first meeting of "Temple Israel Congregation" was held in the old Standard Club Rooms. The first officers were: Mr. Max Baum, president; Mr. G. M. Silverman, vice president; Mr. Lee Stern, secretary. Mr. Joseph Rosenbaum was chairman of the Board of Trustees and Superintendent of the Religious School whose two teachers were Rose Stern and Hattie Fell. Mrs. Julia Fell present oldest member of our congregregation, Miss Bertha Stern, Mrs. William Baum were the first officers of the Ladies Auxiliary organized in 1904.

Of the twenty-seven charter members Sol Auslander, David Goodstein, I. L. Kobacker, Joseph Michael, Joseph Siegal, G. M. Silverman and Lee Stern are still active leaders in our midst. Rabbi Isidor Reichert was elected our first Rabbi on July 1, 1904 and served to 1908.

The Building Committee included Mr. Sol J. Rosenbaum, Mr. Samuel Stern, Mr. William Baum and Mr. Issadore Frank. The fruition of their splendid work was realized when the Temple was dedicated August 30, 1907. Since then Temple Israel has grown from strength to strength under the successive presidencies of Max Baum, Sol J. Rosenbaum, Joseph Rosenbaum, Lee Stern, and the present president Ivan Rosenbaum. The Rabbis who have served have been Isidor Reichert, J. Dobrin, William Lowenberg, R. Hershon, A. Montaz, Harry Stern, Samuel Baron, and the present incumbent Henry E. Kagan. Through the loyalty of it's membership, the zeal of the Sisterhood, the strength of the Men's Club, the training in the Religious School and the support of the Union of American Hebrew Congregation, Temple Israel continues to serve the cause of Judaism and the good citizenship of our community.
