of the Temple Israel, was formed. The follow-

for the Temple Israel by giving varied
affairs at different times.

It was decided to give a Whist on
the evening of Wednesday November 2, 1904 in
the Standard Club rooms, every one playing
to pay 25 cents. The ladies of the Society
promised to donate the lunch, which will
be sold at 10 cents a sandwich.
