A special executive meeting was held by ~~the~~ Hadassah ~~at~~ at the home of Mrs. David Turner, the President, July 27th, 1967. The meeting was called to order by the president Mrs. Turner at 8:15 P.M.

Mrs. Turner welcomed everybody and said we must start the new year with vim and vigor. She informed us that we had a big emergency at this time, the war in Israel. She read many letters, correspondences and communications accumulated during the summer months.

The first was a letter from Les Cohen thanking the women of Hadassah for helping to raise \$31,000 cash on rummage sales and emergency calls that were made.

Mrs. Shalometz is to be the Vice President from Aliquippa, Pa. for the coming year.

The spring conference will be held in Butler, Pa.

There was a letter from the White House in answer to the many Telegrams sent from people. Pres. Lyndon Johnson was hoping for the best for the people during the Crises.

There was a received May 23rd from National about the war and peace and hope.

July 14th there was a letter asking for volunteers for Israel (V.I.P.)
May 15th Another letter saying Israel's birthday had been

June 5th The United Jewish Appeal began asking all the U.J.A. help and dollars the women of Hadassah could give.

June 15th Please everyone send a letter to the Senator "Urging Congress to support the U.S. Commitment by action."

June 9th letter Regarding fund raising.

1. Hadassah must not turn over any money Hadassah funds to any other projects this includes U.J.A.

2. Help U.J.A. in addition to Hadassah projects

3. No local welfare fund should come from Hadassah collection
If Hadassah CHAI is collected before or after this crises it belongs to Hadassah.

4. No monies in Treasury is to be given to U.J.A. or Israel bonds or non Hadassah projects.

June 19th Issue now is Peace

June 29th Mt. Scopus is once more in Israel's hands. The first Hadassah Hebrew University Medical Center is on Mt. Scopus. It must be re-born. The beautiful map of U.S. with names of Hadassah chapters was still on the wall. It announced the National Convention in Miami, Florida Sept. 17th to 20th incl. We must work and it will be approved for H.M.O. and the 3 R Campaign (rebuilding-restoration and return to normal maintenance of Mt. Scopus. In other words rebuild Mt. Scopus, - Repair the Medical Center, - Restore Peace time

June 12th There was a letter saying clear the treasury of all money.

Letter from National said, ask for \$18.00 donations emergency fund. Flyers were to be sent by Mrs. Leonard Burger, they were to be known as CHAI or donations toward life. A discussion followed, whether it is an obligation Mrs. Herman Ficks pointed out that we had our own immediate responsibilities towards Hadassah and our Pres. Libby L. Braum.

June 12th letter said that our Quota is the same as last year

\$3655 & 5%

The Quota sent in last was \$3122

Mrs Turner Said we must arrange for an all day speaker at the Conference, a Regional Conference of 4 Chapters, Wed. Aug. 28th the date set for the meeting.

Mrs. Turner said that the calendar meetings are not known yet because of contact with the Center.

There was discussion among the members concerning the changing of our meeting night to some other night beside Wed, Nothing changed.

The 53rd Annual Convention will be held in Miami, Florida Sept. 17th to 20th. It was unanimously agreed that our Pres. Mrs. Turner should attend as our Delegate.

There was much discussion about filing cabinets to be set up at the Community Center to keep all of our important letters, communications etc. in.

Mrs. Herman Ficks once again asked for the CLOCKARAMA to be used for all of our donations and programs and explained the whole project of selling tickets very thoroughly. We would make enough money to cover all our projects small and others including blue boxes etc. everything but H.M.O. Eight members offered or volunteered to help with the project, but 12 women are needed as chairmen, so it was held over or tabled until the first regular meeting of Hadassah Sept. 27th.

Mrs. Brand suggested giving Bar Mitzvah Monies for National Hadassah for our quota. We must be open to all ways of making money for this purpose.
