SHORT FORM DEED

# This Deed,

MADE the **fourth** day of **October** in the year nineteen hundred and **twenty-four**.

between **William Bush and Rebecca Bush, his wife, of Masontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania, Grantors;**  
AND  
The "**Congregation Beth El, of Masontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania, a corporation of the first class, organized and existing under the laws of Pennsylvania, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Fayette County, Pennsylvania, in Charter Book 6, Page 275, Grantee;**

~~Witnesseth~~, that in consideration of ~~the~~ **the desire of said grantors to foster and perpetuate the Orthodox Jewish Religion,** in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said grantors do hereby grant and convey to the said grantee ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the Borough of Masontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:—Beginning at a point on the East side of Neff Avenue, a corner with Middle Alley; thence extending along the East side of said Neff Avenue in a Northerly direction sixty-six (66) feet to a corner of land formerly owned by Orlando Birard; thence by same in an Easterly direction eighty-two and a half (82½) feet; thence in a Southerly direction by a line parallel with Neff Avenue and Greene Alley and along other lands of the Grantors, sixty six (66) feet to a point in the North side of said Middle Alley; thence in a Westerly direction and along Middle Alley, eighty two and a half (82½) feet <sup>half</sup> to the place of beginning, CONTAINING one-eighth of an acre, more or less. Being the front of the same piece or parcel of land sold and conveyed to the said William Bush and wife by deed of James M. Howard, dated March 6, 1923, and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Fayette County, Pennsylvania, in Deed Book 438, Page 61. AND the said grantors, do hereby warrant generally the property hereby conveyed.
