- 3- Should B'nai B'rith engourage the sharing of dissident viewswithin the total American Jewish community and how should such views be presented to B'nai B'rith members and others?
- 4- What steps must be taken to revitalize the local Lodge?
- 5- Which 8'nai 8'rith programs are most necessary and which are least necessary to the welfare of the American Jewish community?
- 6- Can the American Jewish community continue to maintain massive financial support of Israel in view of the inadequate support being given to American Jewish youth programs?
- 7- Shall B'nai B'rith organize local groups to deal with issues that threaten the Jewish community?
- 8- Shall B'nai B'rith organize rescue efforts for Israeli Jews if the State of Israel should fall?
