The Men's Club


In 1945, with the victorious conclusion of World War II, our young Jewish men began arriving back home singly and in small groups to take their places once again in a peaceful society. However, they brought with them, a new sense of religious and community responsibility which needed as its fulfillment, active participation in their Synagogue.

Recognizing this need, Rabbi Prager, our spiritual leader at the time, met with a group of these young men and the plans for the formation of the Agudath Achim Men's Club were formulated.

The first meeting of the Men's Club held on October 19, 1947 brought out 15 people to partake in Morning Religious Services. At the open forum discussion which followed the aims and purposes were discussed and it was decided that the prime aim of the Men's Club was to join in Morning Worship Service Every Sunday and to cooperate fully with the Officers of our Synagogue in the religious and social activities needs of our Community.

Now . . . ten year's later . . . The Men's Club still continues to uphold these aims and the membership at this Tenth Anniversary Celebration pledges its full cooperation with the Synagogue.
