LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JOSEPH DEROY.

(1) To one Pittsburgh House of Sheltor, of Pittsburgh;

I, Joseph DeRoy, of the City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, hereby expressly revoking and making void any and all wills at any time heretofore made by me.

First. I give, devise and bequeath unto my executors hereinafter named the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars, which shall be used by my executors for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a memorial to myself and my deceased wife, Lydia DeRoy, at the J.M. Gusky Hebrew Orphanage and Home of Western Pennsylvania. The form which this memorial shall take is left to the absolute discretion of my executors, who shall have the right to determine how much, if any, of said fund shall be used for the establishment of said memorial, and how much, if any, thereof shall be given to said Institution to invest and to use the income therefrom for the maintenance of said memorial.

Second. I give, devise and bequeath the following amounts to the endowment funds of the following Institutions or organizations, to-wit:-

- (a) To the Federation of the Jewish Philantropies of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00)

 Dollars, the income from which is to be credited annually as membership dues in my name and to be used in furthering the general objects of the Federation.
- (b) To the Montefore Hospital, of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.
- (c) To the United Hebrew Relief Association of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
- (d) To the Jewish Home for the Aged of Pittsburgh,
 Pennsylvania, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
- (e) To the Irene Kaufmann Settlement, of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
