Rabbi Leifer, on behalf of the BIC Sist.

it is my pleasure to welcome the honored Rabbis and Cantor, and the many friends and members who have come to join us.

This occasion is a double SIMCHAH for the Sist. because while we are participating in this MITZVAH of dedicating the new Torah, we are at the same time oberserving Sist. own 10th anniversary of existance.

Today however is a special day in more ways than one: on the Jewish calendar, today is the 7th day of Adar, commemorating both the birthdayxandxthexYhzeitx
Yhrzeit of Moses and his birthdate. Just as

Moses received the Torah on Mt. Sinai, so is BIC, and on the occasion of his birthday.

During the daily morning prayers, in
every Synagogue, there is a particular prayer
I would like to mention and that is
Maimonides 13 Principles of Faith. There are
2 principles inxparticular which pertain more
vividly to this Torah dedication: the 8th and
the 9th and I would like to read them to you:

- 8) I BELIEVE WITH PERFECT FAITH THAT THE
 WHOLE TORAH, NOW IN OUR POSSESSION, IS THE
 SAME ONE THAT WAS GIVEN TO MOSES, OUR TEACHER.
 PEACH BE UNTO HIM.
- AND 9) I BELIEVE WITH PERFECT FAITH THAT XXXXX THIS TORAH WILL NOT BE CHANGED, AND THAT THERE WILL NEVER BE ANY OTHER LAW FROM THE CREATOR.

 BLESSEd be his name.

TODAY we recite these principles of faith with feeling and emotion: for today we have been able to feel them in our hearts. We have felt the meaning and understood.; and we are obeying the principles which up to now have been recited.

A TORAH DEDICATION SUCH AS THIS IS, IS AN EXPERIENCE WHICH DOES NOT ENTER INTO EVERYONE'S LIFE. JUST AS BUILDING A SYSNAGOGUE, LIKE THIS ONE, IS NOT AN ORDINARY ACCOMPLISHMENT. THESE ARE ONCE IN A LIFETIME EVENTS. WE ARE the fortunate ones. and we are PERPETUATING JUDAISM IN A MOST REALISTIC WAY.

RABBI LEIFER, WE ARE INDEBTED TO YOU FOR YOUR EFFORTS IN OBTAINING A NEW TORAH.

THERE IS A SAYING, "BEHIND EVERY MAN STANDS
A WOMEN", BUT YOU ARE NOT MARRIED, YET, RABBI.

THE TORAH IS XWEXNE STANDING BEHIND YOU -- SHE IS YOUR PARTNER.

WE APPRECIATE WHAT YOU HAVE DONE, AND WE ARE PLEASED THAT YOUR HAVE ACCOMPLISHED YOUR GOALS--the NEW TORAH AND THE BIMAH.

BUT MOXST OF ALL WE APPRECIATE AND KCKNOWLEDGE YOUR EFFORTS IN INSTILLING EDUCATION WHERE it is MOST PRECIOUS TO US -- IN OUR CHILDREN.

WHAT YOU HAVE DONE IN BEHALF OF THIS SMALL
JEWISH COMMUNITY REPRESENTS LIVING JUDAISM.

AND WE HOPE AND PRAY

THAT YOU WILL CONTINUE TO TRANSMIT TO US

AND TO OUR CHILDREN

THE TEACHINGS FROM THE TORAH

"THAT IS IN OUR POSSESSION NOW, JUST AS

IT WAS GIVEN TO MOSES."
