

PITTSBURGH LODGE NO. 44, I. O. B. B.

The organization of Pittsburgh Lodge No 44 is assured. On Sunday, March 20th, 1921, Jericho Lodge unanimously voted for consolidation with Saar Sholem and Abraham Lippman Lodges. The latter two lodges had previously voted unanimously for amalgamation. April 3rd, 1921, is the day set for the first meeting of the consolidated lodge.

Consolidation means a new era in B'nai B'rith work in Pittsburgh. The enthusiasm and spirit aroused indicate that Pittsburgh Lodge No. 44 will carry out to the fullest extent the principles of the Independent Order of B'nai B'rith.

On Sunday afternoon, April 17th, 1921, at the Moose Temple the Jews of Pittsburgh will witness one of the largest and most impressive class initiations ever held in this country. The public will be invited to attend.
