

Three Days of Festivities to Mark Dedication of New Tree of Life Synagogue Building

With the advent of the Jewish New Year, symbolic of Israel's dedication to the principles and faith of the Patriarchs, the eighty-eight year old Tree of Life Congregation will record a memorable epoch in the communal and religious life of Pittsburgh by observing three days of Festivities (October 17, 18, 19) dedicating the new Tree of Life Synagogue building on Wilkins and Shady Avenues.

The specially arranged Friday evening service, October 17, at 8:15 o'clock will begin the impressive Procession with Torah Scrolls, led by Doctor Herman Hailperin, Rabbi of the Tree of Life Congregation, the Officers and Board of Directors.

The Ark will be opened by the Honorary President, Mr. Charles J. Rosenbloom, whose gift of the land made possible the present synagogue site.

Cantor Israel Tabatsky, of Temple B'nai Israel, McKeesport, will chant the liturgical solos, assisted

by the Tree of Life Choir under the direction of Cyrus B. Hailperin, organist and musical director.

Following the dedicatory address of Rabbi Hailperin, the choir will sing the Hallelujah, Psalm 150, arranged for this service by Charles S. Davidson, a member of the Tree of Life Music Ministry, now serving in the Armed Forces in Korea.

Participating in the service will be Rabbi Pincus F. Miller of Beth El Synagogue; Rabbi Philip Frankel of Temple Emanuel, Mt. Lebanon; Dr. Albert B. Berkowitz, President of the Tree of Life Congregation; Mr. Samuel M. Fischer, Building Committee Chairman; Mr. Louis Gordon Jr., Honorary President; and Mr. Aaron Young, Chairman of Arrangements.

Sabbath Services on Saturday morning, October 18 at 9 o'clock will be a salute to the religious youth groups of the Tree of Life Congregation. Rabbi Benjamin A. Lichter of B'nai Israel Synagogue will speak on "Prerequisite to Hap-

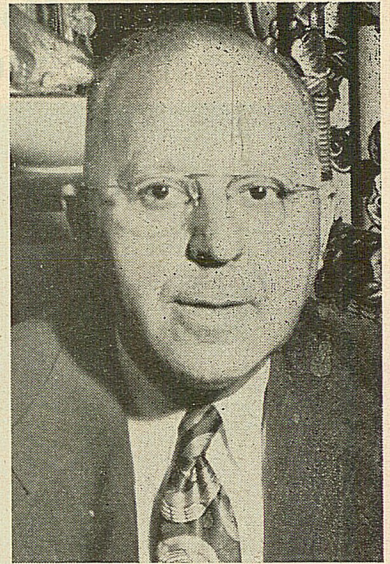

piness for American Jewish Youth." Cantor Mordecai G. Heiser of B'nai Israel Synagogue will chant the liturgical service, assisted by the Tree of Life Choir. Rabbi Hailperin will conduct services, assisted by Mr. Philip Weiner, Secretary of the Congregation.

The Cornerstone Laying Ceremony will take place Sunday afternoon, October 19, at 2 o'clock. When the Cornerstone arrived the other day by air express from Israel, it was noted by officials of T.W.A. that this marked the initial shipment of a cornerstone in the history of air cargo.
