


PREFACE

We are constantly surrounded by manmade spaces resulting from geometric planes that are either horizontal or vertical, and we normally hang art objects on these surfaces or place art objects in the resulting spaces. Our purpose with this exhibition is to look at these same architectural surfaces and spaces in a fresh way so that they do not become mere backgrounds for objects but, as artistic statements, become an inherent part of the organic whole. We have asked participating artists to transform these surfaces and spaces, in two or three dimensions, to create subjective responses within the confines of these surroundings. Our aim has been to expand the current visual, physical, and psychological limitations of architectural environments not normally considered the province of the artist.
