They were all on the verge of collapse from cold and hunger when taken in at the Home. The community can realize what a great necessity such an institution is. We have no visiting days, nor visiting hours. The Home, at corner Stevenson and Gibbon street, is always open for visitors to call and inspect the place, and see just what is being done for our Jewish brethren who require food and shelter until they procure work. There were 29 people registered at the Home during the month of January.
