Whereas, It has pleased the Almighty. in His infinite wisdom, to take unto himself our beloved friend, Simon Shupinsky, the originator and founder of the Hebrew Free Loan Association of Pittsburgh, who generously and untiringly devoted himself to the advancement of the philanthropic objects of the Society. and whose zealous and unsparing services it will be most difficult to replace; and

Whereas, Because of his righteousness, kindness and charity, the deceased has deservedly earned the love and re-

spect of all who knew him; and

Whereas, The Society deeply sympathizes with the widow and family of the deceased in their awful bereavement, hoping that their sorrow may be alleviated by the knowledge that the memory of Simon Shupinsky will be cherished

and honored in this community;

Resolved, That the members of the Hebrew Free Loan Association of Pittsburgh lament the untimely death of Simon Shupinsky, and record their appreciation of his high character and devotion to justice and charity, his inestimable services in the interests of this Society, and its beneficiaries, the affectionate regard with which they now cherish his memory, and the great loss occasioned to the Jewish community in general and to this Society in particular; and be it further
