Charter of ) Charter

WHEREAS, we the undersigned citizens of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania whose names are subscribed to this charter or certificate of incorporation have associated ourselves together for the purposes and upon the terms and by the name herewin stated under the provision of an act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania entitled an Act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain corporations approved the Twenty-ninth day of April in the year of our Lord 1874, and the several supplements thereto, we do hereby therefore set forth and declare that:

- 1. The name of the Corporation is the "Gimaloth Hacodin Society" of Pittsburgh.
2. The purposes for which this corporation is formed for the maintenance of a society for beneficial or protective purposes to its members from funds collected therein.
3. The business of the corporation is to be transacted in the city of Pittsburgh.
4. The Corporation shall have perpetual succession by its corporate name.
5. There is no capital stock nor are there any shares of stock.

The names and residences of the subscribers appear by their signatures hereunto.

- 6. The number of the Officers or Directors of the Corporation is fixed at eight and the names and residences of those who are chosen directors for the first year are as follows:

- 7. The corporation has no capital stock. Fees for membership and annual dues for members will be assessed as the corporation by its by-laws may determine which fees and dues will be applied to promote the purposes for which the corporation is formed. Witness our hands
