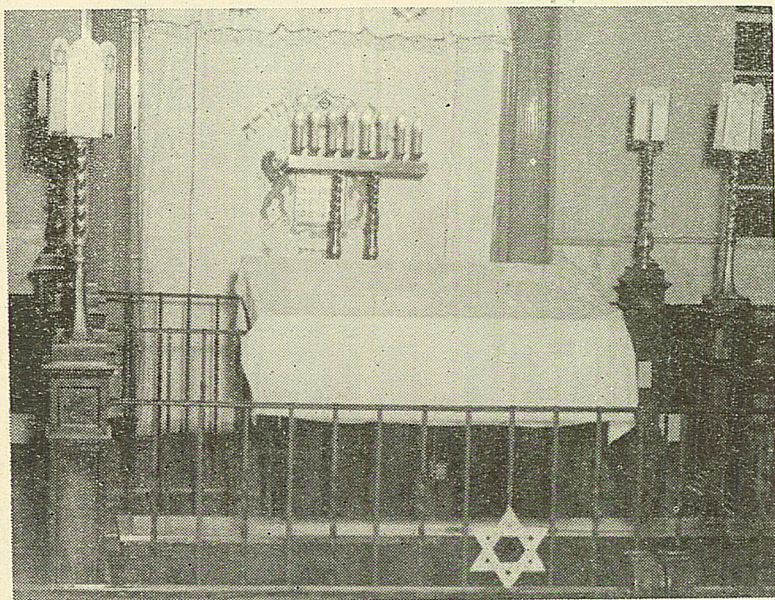


Machsikei Hadas Cong. To Dedicate New Synagogue

Section of the City. The mission has been accomplished, and the new Synagogue, with its Shull and social hall, is now a daily place of worship.
