

February 2, 1975. The Board of Directors Meeting was called to order by the Pres. G. Weiss. It was decided to have a committee of three to meet with Mr. A. L. Brand from the Beth Abraham Congregation to get going with the rebuilding of the Shul. Also it was agreed on the next meeting of all the Members shall be on February 23rd, at 4 P M.. On Purim we will dawn Schachres 6.30 A M. From this Schabbos on each Member or non Member to take turns in paying for the treat Schabbos Morning, also Shalu Schudes. A strong demand was made that the dues to be raised to \$50.00 for Members, which will include the seats for the Yom Tov. Non Members will be \$25.00, without seats for Yom Tov, also no voting rights at our Membership meetings. It was urged by the Pres. for Mothers, and Wives to form a Ladies Auxialary. Please make every effort to bring in new members. Permissin was given the Young Israel to rent our Social Hall for Saturdays Mornings. A donation to give our Congregation of \$60.00 a months

February 16, 1975. The Pres. G. Weiss and the Board Members had a very important meeting with the Sec. I. A. Brand from the Beth Abraham Cong. It was decided to go ahead of rebuilding of our Congregation. A question came up about the Yeshiva to continue to learn. Mr. I. H. Zweig will give a Bond for \$10,000.00 to cover any kind damage that might be done by the Students.

February 23, 1975. The meeting was opened up by the Pres. George Weiss. The minutes were read from the last meeting, and were approved by the members present. A motion was made by Dr. A. Rosenthal, and seconded by Mr. H. B. Schabes that members and non members to reserve dates to give a treat on Saturday morning. With the understanding that the members and non members contribute 80% of the dates ^{RES} and 20% will be given by the Congregation. The motion passed. A motion was made by Mr. I. Zytneck, and seconded by Rabbi Y. Roberts that the dues be raised to \$50.00 for members that require two seats for the Yom Toven. Members that require one seat the dues shall be \$37.50. ~~None seat requirements should be \$25.00 be as a members.~~ The members approved Mr. S. Gross and Mr. I. Stander to become members of our Congregation. A suggestion was made to ask the Beth Abraham Congregation to make a loan of \$40,000.00 to be deducted by the tax donation they give us each year of \$1,000.00 till the loan is paid off. The meeting was closed by the Pres. George Weiss.

April 20, 1975. The Board Meeting was to called to order by the Pres. G. Weiss. The following Board Members were present: Mr. J. Kluchman, Mr. J. Bernstein, Rabbi Y. Roberts, Mr. B. Rabinovitz, Mr. I. Green, Mr. I. Zytznick and Mr. A. Schwartz. The Pres. G. Weiss presented the financial condition of the Congregation, also we have a gas bill to pay, and ^{THERE} is no money to pay with. Therefore, it was decided by the Board Members present to write the Yeshivah a registered letter asking to keep their promise of paying for the utilities as agreed. The decision was made by all Board Members without dissent. A letters was mailed out to that affect. A bid was passed to see, about the amount it has to cost to fix up the Congregation, with the help of Bath Abraham Congregation. The following Board were chosen to see Mr. I. A. Brand of Beth Abraham Congregation. The Pres. G. Weiss, the V. Pres. J. Kluchman, Mr. B. Rabinovit, Mr. Mr. J. Bernstein and Rabbi Y. Roberts. The Board Members decided not to pay the gas bill, if the Yeshivah does not send the money due us. If we receive a notice to close the gas we are to take in to the Yeshivah, however, if they still don't pay, than Mr. J. Bernstein will lend the money to the Congregation to pay. It was also decided to suggest to have Friday evening one Minjan at 7.30 P. M. Also in the mornings except Sunday to start 7 A. M.

CALLED TO

June 1, 1975. The Board Meeting was at order by the Pres. G. Weiss. The following members were present. Mr. B. Kottler, Mr. I. Deutsch, V. Pres. J. Kluchman, Rabbi Y. Roberts, Rev. M. Weingarten and Mr. B. Rabinovitz. It was decided that Mr. B. Rabinovitz to call Mr. I. A. Brand to start to fix up the Schull in the amount of \$5,000.00. Incase heresufuses to borrow that sume, and start to do it now. Also it was decided to send a letter to the Yeshivah after June 22nd, they cannot use the Kitchen. New locks is to put on on all doors. A copy of that letter to be mailed to the President of the Yeshivah. About Baltwillies for Yomtov came up Rev. M. Weingarten will let us know ^{Kevin} around the 20th of June whether he will be a Baltwille, Mr. I. Deutsch was undercided at this time, he will let us know soon. A meeting of all the members will be held on July 20th, at 7 P M. It was also decided to send letters to all Members including statements stating the new rate hich will \$50.00 including two seats. Non Members will be \$18.00 a seat.

July 20, 1975. The meeting was called to order by the Pres. George Weiss. The minutes were read. A motion was made Rabbi Y. Roberts and seconded by Mr. M. Joskowitz to approve the minutes. An appeal was made by the Pres. to the Members present to please pay their dues now, as the Congregation needs the funds very urgently. The Members were against cooperating with the Rodeff Scholem Temple by giving them a list of our membership. A standing Committee were appointed to visit Members in case G'd forbid don't well, the Committee are Rabbi Y. Roberts, Mr. I. Zytneck, Mr. A. Schwartz and Mr. M. Joskovitz. The Members requested the Pres. to ask for the full amount of the replacement of the glass in the front door. The Officers and Mr. B. Kottler were appointed to go to see Rabbi I. Marine, and ^{ask} their influence to ask Rabbi I. Marine to come back to our Congregation, as the Members miss the Rabbi very much. A Committee was appointed to get the Baltwilles, they are the Teas. H. Santman, the Gabbi Rabbi Y. Roberts, Mr. M. Bernstein and A. Schwartz. The Members instructed the Treas. H. Santman to give from now on \$3.00 to Collectors of Yeshivas etc. The next meeting will be G'd willing Oct. 5, 7 P M. The Committee for the Baltwilles were instructed not to go over the \$900.00 amount for both Schachress and Musseff.

October 4, 1975.

It was decided to elect six Board Members. The first Gabie and the second Gabie has a right to be on the Board. Also no disclosure of the votes after the election. The first Gabie should be the one who gets the highest votes, and the second Gabie should be the one who gets next to the Highest votes.

October 5, 1975

Bernstein, Mr. A. L. Butler, Mr. I. Deutsch, Mr. I. M. Klahr, Mr. A. Schwartz and Mr. I. Zytnick. The meeting was closed by the Pres. I. Zweig.

Feb. 7, 1976

The Board of Directors meeting was called to order by the Pres. I. Zweig. The Members of our Congregation ^{feel} ~~feel~~ it is very important to have a place where a Person from out of Town shall have a place where he can sleep over a night or two. It was decided to fix up two rooms upstairs for the purpose. A Committee was appointed to take action. The Pres. I. Zweig and Mr. A. Schwartz is in that Committee. They are to see Rabbi of Schaara Torah, Poala Zadek and Beth Scholom Congregations, to help with project with financial help. Also Mr. A. Butler promised to take a hand with it through a certain fund. It was also discussed to sell a Sefer Torah, under certain conditions which ^{HAS} ~~are~~ to be worked out. Also our regular Balkir ~~is~~ is planning to go to a Yeshvah, therefore, we have try get anothe Balkir in about six months.

Weingarten will be asked to dawn museff. Mr. G. Weiss proposed two new members. They are Mr. S. Horowitz, and Mr. D. Lempel. Also came up to ask for Schabbos morning treat \$15.00 and for Schalu Schudes \$9.00. The regular meeting for May 16th was called off by the Pres. I. Zweig.

July 28, 1976. The Board meeting was called to order by the Pres. I. H. Zweig. It was decided to appoint a group of small committees to ^{go} out to try to collect a substantial fund for the repair of our Congregation. Also it was discussed about the Janitor, that there has been a lot of complains from the members, ^{also} from none members that come in to our Schull. A letter is being sent out that he should leave the building. A time of tenn days was giving him to do so. Also it was reprinted that the romm for Hanuses Orchim is getting ready in ^a short time.

Oct. 29, 1976 The meeting was opened by the Pres. I. Zweig. The Pres. I. Zweig announced that Treas. H. Santman is resigning as of the present meeting. Mr. G. Weiss suggested that Mr. H. Santman become a life member of the Board of Directors. Mr. J. Bernstein was appointed the chairman of the election. A motion was made by Mr. H. B. Schabes, and seconded by Mr. S. Horowitz that a Gabbie Rischon and Gabie Scheinie be elected separately. The motion passed. The following officers were elected. Pres. I. Zweig, V. Pres. J. Bernstein, Treas. A. Schwartz, and Sec. Benj. L. Dickman. Gabie Rischon Rev. M. Weingarten, Gabie Scheinie Mr. I. Deutsch. The following members were elected to the Board of Directors. Mr. A. Butler, Mr. I. Green, Mr. S. Horowitz, Mr. D. Lempel, Mr. H. B. Schabes and Mr. I. Zytneck. It was decided to have board meetings every two months the first Sunday of the month. The first board meeting will be G'd willing Nov. 14, 1976 6 P M. The meeting was closed by the Pres. I. Zweig.

Nov. 14, 1976. The board meeting was opened up by the Pres. I. Zweig. Different things were discussed for the benefit for the Congregation among the subjects came up the the way the Schull is kept by the Rev. I. Weiss. It was suggested to talk about with Rev. I. Weiss to do better. The Pres. took upon himself to see to it that it should done much better, than till now. Also it was decided not charge the Rev. I. Weiss dues. Also it was decided that Rev. M. Weingarten to return the Schull the \$50.00 he promised to return. Mr. H. Santman took upon himself to see to it that the \$50.00 to be given back in the morning.

January 23, 1977. The Board meeting was opened by the Pres. I. Zweig to discuss ~~the~~ to let the Kolel to use our social hall. Mr. Seymour Weis had requested through our Pre. to call ~~the~~ this meeting. The Board members made a suggestion that all utilities to be paid the the Kolel. All expenses to fix up the hall, and all the plumbing work that would have to be done shall be paid by the Kolel. No parking will be permitted by the Kolel on our driveway. They will not help us out with helping us to make a minjan. The Pres. is to take up the above points and other points with Mr. Seymour Weiss, and call another Board Meeting to make a final dedision.

February 27, 1977 . The Board of Directors met with the Representatives of the Kolel. Permission was given by the Board for the Kolel to come in to our Congregation to use the Social Hall for learning. It was decided that the Kolel is to pay above the amount what we used to pay for all utilities. With G'ds help they hope to come in right after Pessach. It was also decided at that Board meeting with the Kolel if would be unable to pay, than Mr. S. Weiss and Mr. I. Zweig will take care of the funds due the Congregation the ^{FOR} utilities.

July 20, 1977. The Board Meeting was opened by the Pres. I. Zweig. It was brought out that all Saifer Torahs Rabbi A. Leifer has in Schull were stolen, Threrefore, a motion was made by Mr. H. B. Schabes, and seconded by Mr. J. Kluchman to give a Saifer Torah to Rabbi A. Leifer. The motion passed. Also it was decided that to ask Rabbi A. Leifer to be the baltwille for the Yom Toven for a su^h of \$1,00.00. \$500.00 the Congreagation will give, the other \$500.00 will raise Mr. H. B. Schabes and the Pres. I. Zweig. In order for the Rabbi to do that he would living quarters. A Committee was appointed to look into that. Mr. A. Schwartz, Mr. G. Weiss, and Mrs. I. Zweig are in that commette.

October 10, 1977. The meeting was called to order by the Pres. I. Zweig. Mr. H. B. Schabes asked that the Officers, and ones that draw a salary should try to see to it that ^{the} Schull should be kept in better condition than till now. Also the Officers, and the Members to make every effort to bring in new Members. ~~The~~ President asked that the Members to please help out with the Minjan during the week if they can do so. A ^{ASE} prsise was givin to the Treasurer that during his admisnin- tration not a cent was deawn out from the Reserve in the Bank. Than the Pres. asked the V. P. J. Bernstein to run the election of Officers. By acclimation the following were elected Pres. I. Zweig, V. P. J. Bernstein, Treas. A. Schwartx and Sec. Benj. L. Dickman. It was decided not elect any Gaiom at the time, instead the Pres. to choose from the Members every four weeks a Gabby. It was decided to vote for a new Member ~~for~~ for the Board, and Mr. M. Joskovitz was elected as a new Member of the Board. Mr. H. B. Schabes brought two new Members his Son Mr. A. Schabes, and his Son S. M. Schabes. Rabbi Y. Roberts made a motion that they be accepted, and was seconded by Mr. B. Rabinovitz, The motion was approved by ~~the~~ the Members present. The meeting was closed by the B. P. J. Bernstein.

July 16, 1978. The special meeting was called to order by the Pres. I. Zweig. The main reason for this meeting is make arrangements for Baltweilles for the Jom Toven. Rev. M. Weingarten asked about the Baltwilles. That is the reason for this meeting. As the finance is not any better this year as last year, therefore, we have to ask our Members to do us a favor and do the same thing as last year. That is to be the Baltwilles this year again. A motion was made by the V. Pres. J. Bernstein to close the meeting, and seconded by the Board Member Mr. B. Rabinovitz.

Nov. 12, 1978. The meeting was called to order by the Pres. I. Zweig. A motion was made by Mr. H. Schabes, and second by Mr. B. Rabinovitz that ^{the} present officers shall be reelected for another term. The motion was approved by the members present. The following members were at this meeting: J. Bernstein, A. Butler, I. Deutsch, Benj. L. Dickman, I. Green, M. Joskovitz, A. Klahr, B. Rabinovitz, H. B. Schabes, A. Schwartz, Rev. I. Weiss and I. Zweig. Mr. H. B. Schabes took up the discussion about keeping the Schull cleaner than it is now. Rev. I. Weiss was approached about helping to keep the Schull cleaner. He promised to get some one for \$10.00 a month to do that. The members approved that idea very much. At the next meeting it was decided to have a list of the Board Members, and the financial status of the Schull present. The following members are on the Board. J. Bernstein, A. Butler, I. Deutsch, I. Green, M. Joskovitz, D. Lempel, B. Rabinovitz, Rabbi Y. Roberts, H. B. Schabes and I. Zytnick. Mr. A. Butler made a motion to close the meeting.

Schabos suggested that the meeting we had on June 24, 1979 shall be ~~decl~~ declared null and void as of this day. The Board Members ^{AGREED} that things shall become normal, we shall Dawn together, and get along with each other for the good of the Congregation, and for good of the Members, and none Members ~~that~~ Dawn with us together.

Oct. 28, 1979 The meeting was opened up by the Prs. I. Zweig for the purpose of Electing new officers for the coming year. The chair was turned over to the V. Pres. J. Bernstein to conduct the meeting. It was decided to elect a Gabbi Rischon and Gabbi Scheinie. A motion was made by Mr. L. Siebzener and seconded by Mr. H. B.
