The undersigned Committee is appealing to the Jewish Community of Pittsburgh for funds to help save a Synagogue Building which is nearing completion at the corner of Webster Avenue and Erin Street. The Synagogue building is that of the KETHER TORAH CONGREGATION.

Work on this Synagogue was started in January of 1920 at a time when the officers and trustees of the Synagogue confidently expected to carry through their building plans with their own funds. Sufficient capital was raised from the Synagogue's own members to purchase the plot of ground at the corner of Webster Avenue and Erin Street and to start the building operations.

The business reverses of the past several months have rendered it impossible for the Trustees and Officers to carry out their plans. They actually face foreclosure as the building is about completed and \$15,000.00 is needed to pay the contractor.

The officers have personally interviewed and solicited the undersigned and we have investigated the condition of affairs.

We realize the necessity of helping to save this Synagogue as it will be a reflection on the community's interest in things Jewish if this Synagogue is not saved.

The Synagogue Building is modern in every respect, being all brick, well ventilated, sanitary and situated at a most desirable corner facing on three streets. It is the only synagogue in the McKELVEY-BEDFORD SCHOOL DISTRICT and will meet a popular demand.

We urge immediate action as the need is pressing. MR. SOL ROSENBLOOM has consented to act as Treasurer of the funds.
