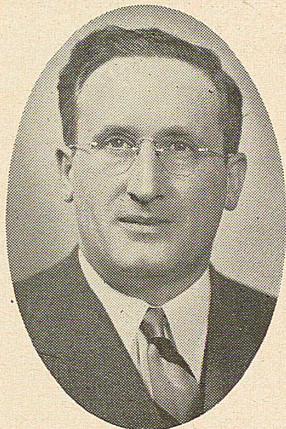
Hebrew Religious Sunday School
