CHRONOLOGY OF THE PLISKOVER FREE LOAN ASSOCIATION  
ON THE OCCASION OF ITS FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY

*By Harry Adler*

With the advent of the Twentieth Century, the history of our Pliskovers began shaping a new kind of life in a new setting, namely the United States.

The life in in Pliskov by our Landslait was just about the same as of any other Jewish Community of its size in Russia, a pretty rugged affair.

Most of the people there barely managed to make ends meet with the meager incomes from their professions. They had to, after a whole week's work go out in search of a "Gemilas-chesed" (loan) to buy the necessities for the Sabbath, which was the one day they could throw off their worries and relax, go to their respective Synagogues for spiritual uplift, and open their hearts in prayer to God, for help in their many problems.

And problems they had plenty. Aside from making a living for their families, there were also such as a son would have to go in the Military Service, or Nadan (dowry) for their grown daughter (which every prospective bridegroom expected to receive), or the Tax Collector, when calling to collect, had to take household valuables, such as feather pillows or the Sabbath Candelabras, as security, knowing that they would be redeemed much more quickly, rather than spending the money for personal needs.

Until one fine day one of the Pliskover families, Laizer Rubenstein, decided to emigrate to America, which was known as The Golden Land, and from then on others followed, who upon reaching their destination were received with open arms by their "Geila-Landslait," who acted as advisors and helped the "Greenhorns" to settle, and also found them jobs.

This closeness brought about a mutual feeling for something more concrete, thus a Landsmanshaft "Pliskover Gemilas Chasudim," or Pliskover Free Loan, came into being, organized by a few of the Pliskovers who settled in Pittsburgh, with a vision for the future to help all newcomers who might be in need, and also exchange views among themselves.

The most plausible place to meet was at the home of Laizer Rubenstein, who besides being considered a veteran, by virtue of being a few years in America, was also a "Machnis-Orach," as was his wife Hannah (Chana). The first meeting was called, and all Pliskover Landsleit were

invited to attend, Officers were picked, and after considerable debate and discussion, a Constitution was established, whereby benefits and dues were agreed upon.

Thus we learn from the first Minutes recorded on August 23, 1908 that a Membership should cost One Dollar, plus dues of ten cents weekly. Every member is entitled to receive financial assistance when in need, and sick benefits of Three Dollars a week.

Also that at any time a Pliskover, even if he is not a member, applies for relief, it should be acted upon by a Committee of seven members.

The first officers were elected September 20, 1908.

A Committee of two, Louis Rubenstein and Aaron Nachman Spector, were appointed to find out about getting a Charter.

On the committee to visit sick members were Lieber Stupansky (Reingold) and Aaron Nachman Spector.

A Relief Committee of four to investigate, consisted of—Laizer Rubenstein, Max Silverman, Ben Zion Sacks and Joseph Rosen.

At a meeting on October 10, 1909, the same Officers were reelected, and a committee to audit the books, composed of Henry Barr, Max Silverman and Sam Reznitsky.

A Relief Committee of five members was appointed—Sam Rosen, Sam Reznitsky, Max Rubenstein, Max Silverman and Louis Moogerman.

Eli Weiner joined the Organization.

March 6, 1910 Meeting.

Sam Katofsky joined the organization.

August 28, 1910 Meeting.

Max Spector and Meyer Gold joined the organization.

At a meeting on October 23, 1910, nominations were held and three new members joined: Sam Kwait (Shaia), Mendel Givetz and Laizer Goretzky.

November 20, 1910.

Sam Calig was elected President; Jacob Bilensky, Vice President; Secretaries same as previous.

December 18, 1910.

Harry Rubenstein was elected Treasurer at a special election, against Abe Calig.

December 31, 1911—Elections held.

March 30, 1913. Leib Shapiro, Israel Verbofsky and Chuna Gold joined.

New members—Abraham H. Levin and Harry Wechsler.

September 28, 1913. Election was held and the following elected.

Recommendation was made by Harry Wechsler that the Organization buy a tract of land for Cemetery purposes. He also suggested that should this fall through, the family of a deceased member to receive \$50.00 from the Organization, plus a tax of \$1.00 from each member.

B. Clair appointed to a Committee.

Harry Roth recommended Harry Feld for membership.

At a meeting on November 23, 1913 a Committee of ten was selected to bring a report regarding the purchase of a "Sefer Torah."

Getzi Mogerman joined the Organization.

At a meeting on February 1, 1914, Morris Verbofsky became a member.

Harry Feld donated a tangible item to the Organization to be raffled. The proceeds were \$23.55 towards the purchase of the "Sefer Torah." Yoel Calig was the lucky winner.

Dissension occurred between the members in regard to purchasing the "Sefer Torah," and after months of conferences and deliberations, an amicable agreement was reached, to the satisfaction of the parties.

At a meeting on March 1, 1914, Thomas Calig was elected Vice President, and Harry Weiner, Treasurer.

William Brody became a member.

At a meeting on June 21, 1914, a motion was made and passed to assess each member \$1.00 toward purchasing the "Sefer Torah"; \$26.00 was collected.

A committee of seven were appointed to arrange for the Seeum Hatorah—Thomas Calig, Leib Shapiro, Morris Rosen, Harry Rubenstein, Harry Weiner, Max Rubenstein and Baruch Clair.

At a meeting in November, 1914, Israel Yudel Weiner and Fishel Linetsky became members.

At a meeting March 7, 1915, following were elected to office:

A motion was passed that beginning with the January, 1916 meeting, same to be held at the Irene Kaufmann Settlement.

A special meeting was held at the home of Eli Weiner, No. 6 Mercer St., for the purpose of purchasing a cemetery. Motion was made that each member pay \$10.00 towards same.

For many years Simcha's Torah Serpices were held at Eli Weiner's home, where many dollars were collected and turned over to the Organization. Chana Esther always served traditional dishes.

It was also reported at this meeting that Lieber Stupansky (Reingold) passed away, and \$24.00 was paid out as funeral expenses.

Nathan Slipoy became a member.

At a meeting on February 4, 1916, a report was given that a cemetery was purchased for the sum of \$1,455.00—\$725.00 cash and the balance of \$730.00 in 3 year open mortgage.

A Cemetery Committee was appointed—Jacob Rosen, Chairman; Eli Weiner and Sholem Gordon.

All members were invited to go out the following Sunday to inspect the cemetery.

June 3, 1917 meeting reports an application for permit to erect a monument on the grave of Raphael Rosinsky, the first burial in the Pliskover Cemetery.

September 2, 1917. A committee of Laizer Rubenstein, Eli Weiner, Sholem Gordon, Max Rubenstein, Sam Katofsky were appointed to arrange for a survey of the cemetery.

October 17, 1917. Report was given that the Pliskover "Sefer Torah" was read during the Holidays, and the sum of \$28.00 was donated by the members present.

January 6, 1918. Officers Elected.

Report by the Secretary that bill for \$21.00 interest on the mortgage was received. The President suggested that something be paid on the mortgage also.

Max Rubenstein recommended that each member make a donation for the mortgage, and a total of \$30.00 was collected.

Since the Treasury balance was only \$68.17 after all deductions, the Treasurer offered to lend the Organization \$131.83 so that the \$200.00 could be paid on the Principal. The offer was graciously accepted with thanks.

February 3, 1918. Baruch Clair made a motion that the Pliskover Organization pledge its support to the Zionist Movement for Israel, and each member should be a shekel. Motion passed and approved.

Laizer Rubenstein suggested that the members come to the home of Sholem Gordon on Purim Eve to hear reading of the Megila.

April 7, 1918. The Secretary sent in his resignation, and since there were no minutes, Harry Roth acted as Secretary and promised to keep the books, also send meeting notices until another Secretary is appointed.

August 4, 1918. No minutes, due to the absence of the Secretary. Jacob Rosen appointed Secretary for this meeting.

Since this was during the World War I years, with each meeting many of our younger members were called up for service and many office holders had no chance to send in their official resignation.

With the end of World War I, another chapter in the history of our organization began, an enthusiastic movement for the purpose of saving relatives and friends from Russia, from whom they had not heard for the entire period of the war and Revolutions of six years.

Being unable to communicate or send help directly, a delegate was chosen and sent to Roumania, with cash and instruction to contact or find any Pliskovers who managed to escape into Roumania, and help them with money, food, clothes and advice. The Pliskovers who later



came to the United States are a living testimonial to this great achievement. This was done through the cooperation of our many Landslait throughout the United States who joined with us under the title of United Pliskover Relief, with headquarters in Pittsburgh.

A third achievement in the history of our Organization was during the great Depression of the 1930's, when the Special Loan Fund was established, under the same charter, for the purpose of helping each other financially. With great pride we can point out that during the 24 years of its existence, a total of over a half-million dollars business was transacted, and from the last report of the Financial Secretary, Mr. Ben M. Kaufman, we learn that we have a balance of \$40,000 in the bank and in Government Bonds.

All good standing members of the main organization are eligible to join this branch.

It is worth mentioning that we were instrumental in organizing the Pliskover Ladies Auxiliary on November 17, 1929 under the able leadership of Herman S. Radin, Chaim Verbofsky, Harry Roth, B. Clair and others. To this day the Ladies Organization has grown to a membership of 103, and is recognized in our community for its work in charity and general good deeds.

Also, for a time there was a Junior Pliskover Organization, who issued a monthly bulletin, of which I have in my possession the third issue, which was well edited by its staff:

And now the final chapter in our Fifty Years of Accomplishment.

During the Second World War many of our members, also sons and daughters of members, served their country with honor and distinction.

Those at home contributed by buying Savings Stamps and Bonds. This was a feature at practically every meeting. Our friend Harry Roth would bring in a supply of stamps and sell them (without profit).

When in 1948 the State of Israel was established, our organization supported the rebuilding of the country, as a refuge for all of our Jewish people, who have suffered more than any other nationality.

In 1950 a movement to purchase a tract of land in Israel, as a Memorial to our Pliskover Martyrs of both wars, was started in conjunction

with New York, Cleveland, Erie and Chicago Landslait. By 1953, the first installment of \$7500.00 was delivered to the Jewish National Fund. In 1954 when the balance of \$2500.00 was delivered, a deed as to size and location was recorded in the Archives of the Jewish National Fund in the name of Nachlath Pliskov. During a trip to Israel in 1953, Harry and Bessie Roth were present at the Dedication Ceremonies of the Nachla. Sam Levin and his wife, from Cleveland, also visited the Nachla on their trip to Israel.

I want to thank Harry Roth and Baruch Clair for their support and help in compiling these records.

1949

The year that we located a refugee girl in Europe and gave her help. Pliskover Ladies Auxiliary donated a Bond to be used in building a new chapel.

The refugee girl came to Pittsburgh enroute to Australia and stayed at the home of Mr. and Mrs. B. Clair.

1950

New road and concrete walks were built on our cemetery.

Moved to our new meeting room at the B'nai Emunoh Synagogue. Cleveland Pliskover celebrated the 10th Anniversary in November and Harry Adler attended the affair as the Official Delegate.

1951

Ladies Auxiliary decorated Chapel with new drapes and benches.

Mr. H. S. Radin was General Chairman of the 45th Anniversary affair. 113 people present; all had a good time.

Ladies sent us a gift of \$250.00 and our Pliskover Landslait Society from Cleveland, Ohio, sent us a gift of \$25.00.

Harry Roth makes a trip to Israel and brings back movies of his trip. Max Seigal, a Pliskover from Chicago, visits Pittsburgh and our meeting.

Brucha-Molka Family Club donated two concrete benches in their memory.

1954

Avineri Family located in Israel and we corresponded and sent them packages.

Cemetery improved road and walks extended.

Installation and Officers' Party at Joseph's Steak House.

1955

Motion passed that \$10.00 must accompany the membership application.

Care packages sent to all Pliskover in Israel for Passover.

A Simchas Torah affair held at the home of Mr. and Mrs. David Weiner. Mr. Baruch Clair read the Torah.

Abe Pearl suggests that we start planning the Fiftieth Anniversary of the organization.

Harry Adler sent as delegate to the Labor Zionist fiftieth anniversary dinner.

Hyman Verbofsky, past president and outstanding worker for the organization dies August 1, 1955.

The organization buys \$200.00 worth of Israel Bonds in honor of Baruch Clair, who has always worked for the establishment of the State of Israel.

1956

We purchase a plot of land across from the cemetery in Kennedy Township. Harry Adler retires as Financial Secretary of the organization after thirty-five years of faithful service. He is presented with a gift and is made an Honorary Board of Director for life.

Herman S. Radin died March 8, 1956. He was past president of the organization and founder and secretary of the special Loan Fund. Meeting was postponed in his memory.

We dedicate two benches at the cemetery in memory of Hyman Verbofsky and Herman S. Radin. Mr. Bennett M. Kaufman and Mr. Baruch Clair spoke. Mr. Baruch Clair tells the members of the organization of his trip to Israel. We erect a utility building at the cemetery.

1957

The Men's and Ladies' organization join in having a Purim affair Sunday, March 17, 1957. David Rosen, Chairman, reported that it was a great success; that 213 people enjoyed the show and that it was done in professional style; and that we should be proud of our achievement.

David Weiner appointed Chairman of the Fiftieth Anniversary Affair to be held March, 1958.

First issue of the Pliskover News is printed and is well received by the membership.

Congratulations and best wishes to the Pliskover Free Loan Association on its Fiftieth Anniversary.

It is indeed an honor and a privilege to be a part of the organization during the years of its existence, working together with many whose names appear on the records and minutes books.

I bow my head in memory of those gone to their Eternal Rest.

And with respect and admiration to our present Officers and members.

May your accomplishments be many in the future years before you.
