Investigation and report having been made by this Department, you are hereby notified that under the provisions of an executive order of the President, dated the 26th day of November, 1918, excepting certain persons from the classification of alien enemy under the provisions of Subdivision Eleven of the Act of Congress approved May 9, 1918, your name has been certified to the Secretary of Labor, by virtue whereof you are excepted from the classification of alien enemy solely for the purpose of conferring upon you the privilege of applying for naturalization according to law, after due notice to the Commissioner of Naturalization as prescribed by the provisions of Subdivision Eleven of the Act of Congress approved May 2, 1918. Any further questions pertaining to your naturalization should be addressed to the Commissioner of Naturalization, Department of Labor, Washington, D. C. Unless and until you become fully naturalized as an American citizen you remain subject to all of the laws and regulations affecting alien enemies.
