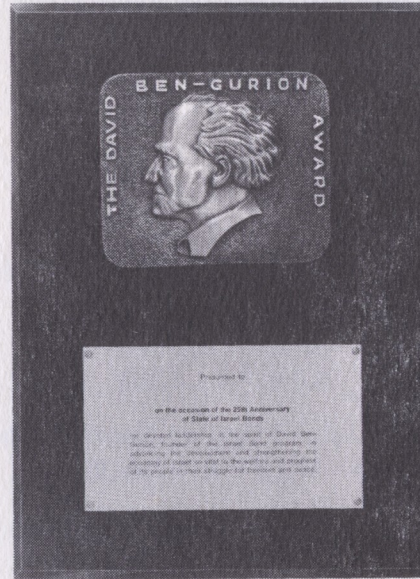
It is especially appropriate that this year the State of Israel will honor Joseph Mirow with its coveted David Ben-Gurion Award, named for the first Prime Minister of the State of Israel and the Founder of the Israel Bond program.

Joseph Mirow took on the responsibility of being the first Israel Bond campaign chairman in New Castle 25 years ago when the program had just begun.

The Ben-Gurion Award commemorates the twenty-fifth anniversary of the Israel Bond Organization, which had its origin in September, 1950 at the Jerusalem Conference convened by Prime Minister Ben-Gurion.

The plaque will be presented to Joseph Mirow "for devoted leadership, in the spirit of David Ben-Gurion, founder of the Israel Bond program, in advancing the development and strengthening the economy of Israel so vital to the welfare and progress of its people in their struggle for freedom and peace."

Joseph Mirow is a past president of Tifereth Israel Congregation and of its men's club. He is a life member of the ZOA, a member of the Jewish Welfare Board, of B'nai B'rith, the American Legion and the Veteran's Council.
