



FIRE caused \$5,000 damage to the Kosher Restaurant early Monday morning, it was estimated by Abe Dunn, vice-president of the corporation that owns the restaurant. Complete redecoration of facilities will be necessary, Mr. Dunn said. He expects the restaurant, at 1718 Murray Ave., to reopen Sunday, April 5, the day after Passover ends. The general-alarm blaze, which started next door to the restaurant at Harry's American Bar, also hit Kaufman's Market and John's Coffee Shop. Six persons were forced to flee nearby apartments at 1718-8 Murray Avenue.
