

## Historical Landmark

TALMUDICAL Institute and Mesivta of Pittsburgh has acquired the landmark structure at 5807 Bartlett Street in Sq. Hill, as part of the growing facilities of the institution. To be known as the Solomon and Eva Glick Hall, the building was occupied for more than three decades by the late Rabbi Joseph Leifer and until their departure to settle in Eretz Israel, by Rabbi Abraham Leifer and the Leifer family. The Institute will continue to use the facilities of the Shaare Zedeck Congregation and the Shaare Tefillah Congregation on Bartlett Street for Beth Medrash classes as well as for the Mesivta High School classrooms. Plans for a public dedication of the Solomon and Eva Glick Hall are being formulated by the Dedication Committee and will be announced at a later date.
