of the American Jewish Committee

We, the undersigned officers of the American Jewish Committee, in consideration of the expressed desire and intent of those whose names appear below, to implement within the community of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania the policies, program and objectives of the American Jewish Committee, as set forth in its Charter and defined from time to time by the officers and executive committee of said Committee, have granted this revocable Charter and with it all the rights, privileges and responsibilities guaranteed to a chapter by the Charter and By-Laws of the American Jewish Committee.

"The objects of this corporation shall be, to prevent the infraction of the civil and religious rights of Jews, in any part of the world; to render all lawful assistance and to take appropriate remedial action in the event of threatened or actual invasion or restriction of such rights, or of unfavorable discrimination with respect thereto; to secure for Jews equality of economic, social and educational opportunity; to alleviate the consequences of persecution and to afford relief from calamities affecting Jews, wherever they may occur."
