A MESSAGE

After so many years as a chaplain, I have learned. He has to have the dedication of a saint and the will power of a great man combined in one package, reflecting a man who is wholly dedicated to the service of his fellowmen.

He has to demonstrate tolerance, flexibility, diplomacy and sensitivity to the needs of others regardless of what they may be, or whom they may be.

He has to have a pleasant personality, a sense of honor, humor and sincerity that enables him to relate to all people of all ages and backgrounds - inferior, equal, or superior to him.

The community has also a large responsibility. They must care for all the members of the institutions. They must provide them with those requirements which they cannot individually obtain. They must lessen human misery. They must remove pain and suffering. They must find rest for the broken in spirit and in body. They must teach them self-understanding and guidance. They must care about them, to love them. They have to bring the resources of religion during their stay in the institution. These include worship and rituals, or just a friendly visit. They have to do it themselves with their heart, with their might and with their compassion. These residents of the state institutions need someone to care about them. Many of them are forgotten, and neglected, their life is miserable, their mental disorders have caused them to lose touch with their normal brothers. They feel abandoned and unwanted.

This Special Day of celebration has a twofold purpose: First and foremost, to bring a message of faith, hope and love to our "Exceptional Citizens". These people have no one. They need to feel that somewhere there are those who do care about them. Second, for the communities of Western Pennsylvania it is a reminder of its responsibility and commitment towards these oft-forgotten "Children of G-d".

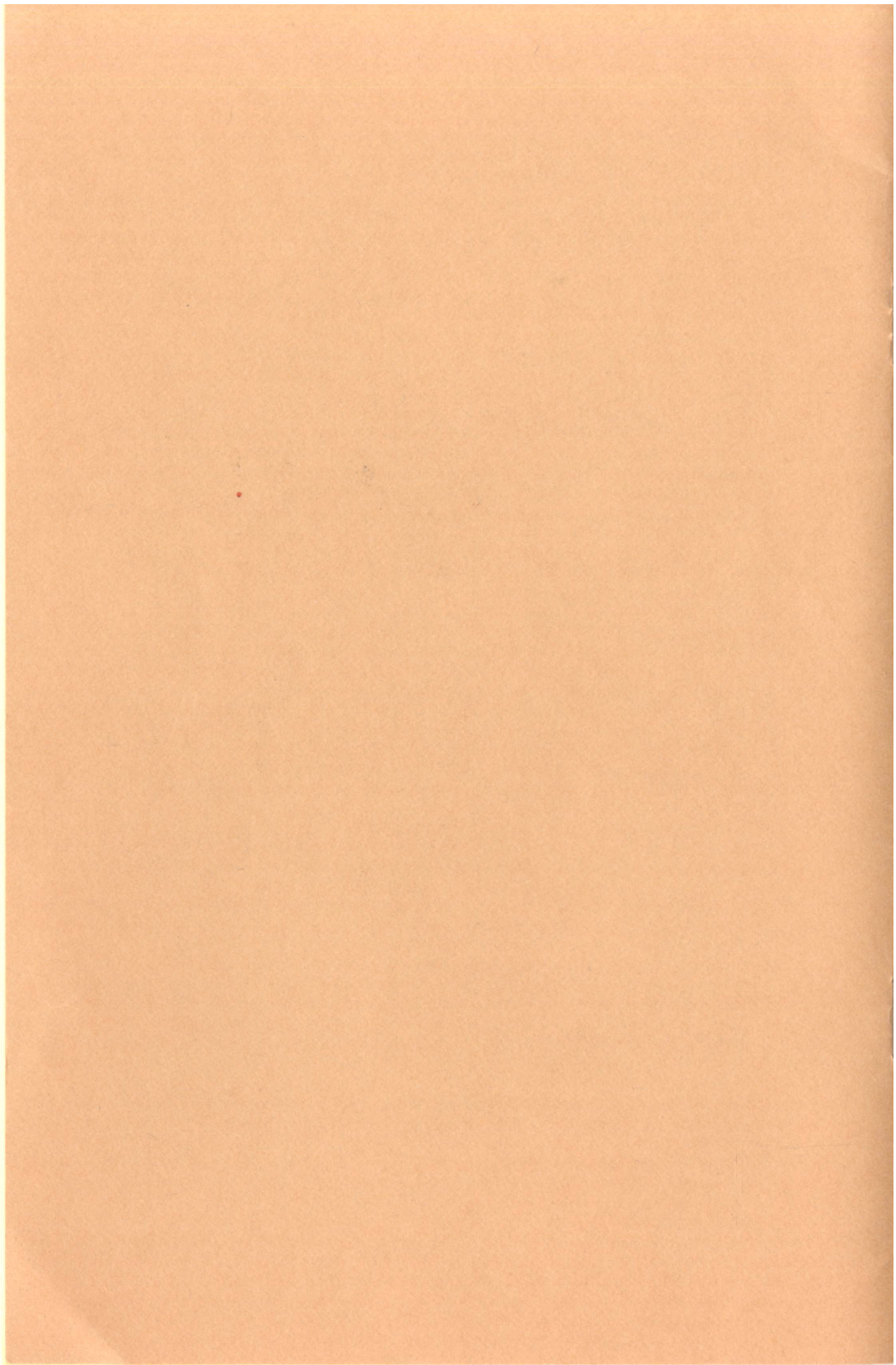
