## SPEAKERS

**Mary Fisher** is the founder of the Family AIDS Network, Inc., a Washington-based non-profit organization dedicated to increasing awareness, compassion and resources with which to fight the AIDS epidemic. Diagnosed with HIV in 1991, she gained national prominence with a moving speech about AIDS at the 1992 Republican National Convention.

**Beverly and Melvin Pollock** have lost a son to AIDS. They are volunteers with the Shepherd Wellness Community and Beverly serves as the President. In addition they were the founders of "Jews with AIDS in the Family", a group funded by the United Jewish Federation under the auspices of the Jewish Family and Children's Service.

**Deborah DeAngelo** serves as Development Director for the Northeast Florida AIDS Network. She assists community agencies which serve people with HIV and AIDS in providing educational presentations for businesses, civic organizations and schools.

**Paul R. Rogers, M.D.**, heads the Intensive Care Unit at the Veterans Hospital in Oakland and has been active the the Pittsburgh AIDS Task Force since 1988.
