Homewood-Brushton and Wilkinsburg Religious School:—Under the auspices of the Council of Jewish Women a religious school has been reorganized in the Homewood, Brushton and Wilkinsburg districts. Sessions are held every Sunday morning on the third floor of the Homewood National Bank Building, corner Kelly and Homewood Streets.

Shortly before the holiday season, Miss Miriam Schoenfeld of the Council of Jewish Women organized the school, appointing Mr. Herbert Polesie, superintendent and the Misses Ruth Soltz, Clara Hahn and Minnie Bloomer, teachers. Thirty-five children were enrolled at that time and from present indications it is expected that the attendance will reach one hundred before long. All parents in the above mentioned districts are asked to enroll their children immediately.

Through the kindness of Mr. Harry Neiman each child was presented with a "succoth" bag containing fruit and candy. In the evening a Succoth Festival was held, an excelled programme in which the children and popular local talent participated. Mr. A. Levitan brought a small Succoth of his own construction and each child contributed a piece of fruit which was given to the Home for the Poor.

A mother's club was recently organized by Miss Schoenfield which promises active support for the school. Mrs. Harry Neiman was elected president. The men have also prom-

ised the school support. With such splendid co-operation, a successful year is promised.
