
RESTAURANT CUTS PRICES OF DINNERS

Drastic reductions in prices, in keeping with the general trend of business moves, have been announced for the "Y" Samovar, by Maurice Haber, proprietor. The quality of the food, which has always been of the highest, will continue the same, Haber states.

The Samovar special dinner, the feature meal on the restaurant menu, which heretofore has sold for one dollar, has been reduced to ninety cents; the special dinner, formerly priced at eighty-five cents has been reduced to seventy-five cents.

The former meal includes choice of entrees and soup; half of a broiled spring chicken with browned potatoes; salads; side dishes; ices; cake, and iced tea or soda. The new seventy-five cent dinner consists of fruit cocktail; choice of soup; choice of broiled rib steak, lamb chops, roast or boiled chicken, or breaded veal chops; french fried potatoes; salads; ices; cookie, and iced tea or soda.

All ala carte specials have also been reduced proportionately and all fifty cent lunches, which have met with great favor with the student membership, will remain the same price, but will carry more and a larger variety of food. The "Y" Samovar is one of the few restaurants in Y. M. H. A.5s throughout the country and has come to have a high reputation with visitors from all over the country.
