

# Hebrew Institute Lists Released-Time Classes

Hebrew Institute, now located at Forbes Street and Denniston Avenue, will again sponsor released-time classes in various neighborhoods. Classes were instituted in 1940 for all high school students wishing to take them under the sponsorship of Catholic, Protestant and Jewish leaders.

## Schedule of Classes

Classes will be conducted as follows: For Taylor Alderdice students, Hebrew Institute, Hazel 8900; Peabody students, B'nai Israel Synagogue, 327 N. Negley Avenue, Montrose 0253; Westinghouse students, B'nai Zion Synagogue, Hamilton and Lang Avenues; Fifth Avenue students, Irene Kaufmann Settlement, 1853 Center Avenue, Grant 0850; and Schenley students, YM&WHA, Mayflower 6500. Bus service to and from the Institute will be provided for Taylor Alderdice students.

Registration will be held Wednesday, September 14, during the first school period.

Students registering for these classes may participate in a city-wide essay contest with prizes totaling \$100. Essays are to be 500 words or less and will be based on subjects covered in the course. Half of the prizes will be awarded to 9 and 10 grade students. Winning essays will be published.
