

New Night Club Opens At Y For Teenagers

On Saturday evening November 30th, Club 315, a teen nite club operated solely by and for teenagers, will open its doors.

Club 315 will feature dancing to an orchestra, floor show with professional talent direct from local nightclubs, and the complete menu of the Y restaurant. Teenagers will serve as waiters and waitresses.

Club 315 is sponsored by the Teen Executives of the Y. This is a group made up of the officers of teen groups at the Y as well as leaders in the Teenlounge and Teen camp.

Club 315 tentatively will be open once a month. Gateway AZA members will act as waiters, doormen and ushers. Admission is \$1.50 for couples only.
