For a Charter of Incorporation

To the Honorable the Judges of the said Court:
 In compliance with the requirements of an Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania entitled "An Act to provide for the Incorporation and regulation of certain corporations approved the 27th day of April A. D. 1874 and the supplements thereto, the undersigned three at least of whom are citizens of Pennsylvania, having associated themselves together for the purpose of applying for a charter of incorporation, for a corporation with the rights and privileges hereinafter set forth. Pray your Honours by a Decree of the Court, to erect them and their successors into a corporation according to law and they do hereby certify

1. Name

The name of the proposed corporation is
 "The Congregation Choye Adam" of Pittsburgh Pennsylvania.

2. Purpose

Said corporation is formed for the purpose of the support of Public worship according to the faith doctrine discipline and usages of the orthodox Hebrew or Israelitish creed, and also to conduct therewith a day school for the education of the youth in the tenets and faith of Israel.

Place of Business

3. The business of said corporation is to be

transacted in the city of Pittsburgh, County of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania.

4. Said corporation is to exist perpetually.

Directors.

5. The number of Directors of said corporation is fixed at Five, a majority of whom shall be lay members, and the names and residences of those who are chosen Directors for the first year are

6. The yearly income of the corporation other than that derived from Real Estate shall not exceed the sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars.

This corporation shall exist and be supported by the payment of membership fee by each person desiring to become a member which is now fixed at no less than \$1.00 each member shall pay dues now fixed at \$ 6.20 per month or Ten cents per week. The further income of this corporation for its support and maintenance, and that of its school, shall be derived from the sale of seats, collections and voluntary contributions. This corporation has no capital stock. This corporation shall hold its services in a room or Hall in the city of Pittsburgh suitable to the purpose, which shall also have a school Room attached.

Property Rights

7th. Any property Real or personal which shall hereafter be bequeathed, devised or conveyed to said corporation shall be taken or held to ensure to it, subject to the control and disposition of the lay members thereof or such constituted officers or representatives thereof as shall be composed of a majority of lay members.
