To the Honorable the Judges of said Court,

In compliance with the requirements of an Act of the general Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled "An Act to provide for the Incorporation and regulation of certain corporations" approved the 29th day of April A.D. 1874, and the supplements thereto, the undersigned three at least of whom are citizens of the State of Pennsylvania, having associated themselves together for the purpose of the support of Public worship and desiring that they may be incorporated according to law, do hereby certify,

First,

The name of the proposed corporation is the Congregation Ahave Sholem (Brethern of Peace) of the City of Pittsburgh Pa.

Second,

Said corporation is formed for the purpose of the support of Public worship according to the faith doctrine, discipline and usages of the Israelitish or Jewish creed.

Third,

The business of said corporation is to be transacted in the City of Pittsburgh, County of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania.

Fourth,

Said Corporation is to exist perpetually.

Fifth.

The number of Directors or Trustees of said Corporation is fixed at five, a majority of whom shall be lay members, and the names and residences of those who are chosen directors or trustees for the first year are

Sixth.

The yearly income of this corporation, other than that derived from real Estate, shall not exceed the sum of Twenty Thousand dollars. This corporation has no capital stock, and will derive its support from the following sources:

- 1st From monthly contributions of the members to be no less than sixty cents (60c) per month
- 2nd From the sale of seats in the Synagogue or church,
- 3rd From voluntary contributions and free offerings,
- 4th Applicants for membership shall pay a fee of at least Two (2) dollars upon their admission to this corporation,

Seventh.

Any property, real or personal, which shall hereafter be bequeathed, devised or conveyed to said corporation shall be taken and held to enure to it, subject to the control and disposition of the lay members thereof or such constituted officers or representatives thereof as shall be composed of a majority of lay members.

Eighth.

This corporation shall hold its services in a Hall, suitable for the purpose, in the City of Pittsburgh,

Ninth.

The rights and privileges of members in good standing in this corporation, to wit: members who have paid their dues and complied with the lawfull rules and

To His Excellency,
James A. Beaver
Governor of Pennsylvania,

Sir:

In compliance with the requirements of an act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of natural gas companies" Approved the 29th. day of May A. D. 1886; the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of Pennsylvania, having associated themselves together for the purpose of producing, dealing in, transporting, storing and supplying natural gas to such persons, corporations or associations within convenient connecting distance of its lines of pipe as may desire to use the same upon such terms and under such reasonable regulations as the gas company shall establish, and desiring that they may be incorporated and that letters patent may issue to them and their successors according to law, do hereby certify:

First: The name of the proposed corporation is "Consumers Heating Company"

Second: Said corporation is formed for the purpose of producing, dealing in, transporting, storing and supplying natural gas.

Third: The place where natural gas is intended to be mined for and produced or received is Ross Township in Allegheny County Pennsylvania.
