- 1899 SISTERHOOD FOUNDED----THEN KNOWN AS LADIES AUXILIARY
- 1901 FIRST FUND RAISING----A BAZAAR---PRESENTED \$1,000.00 TO CONGREGATION
- 1912 LADIES AUXILIARY FIRST BY-LAWS WERE WRITTEN
- 1920 INSTALLED FIRST KITCHEN IN CRAFT AVENUE SYNAGOGUE----ASSUMED RESPONSABILITY FOR DECORATING THE SUKKAH
- 1922 AFFILIATED WITH NATIONAL WOMEN'S LEAGUE FOR CONSERVATIVE JUDAISM----OUR MOTHER ORGANIZATION
- 1923 GIVEN REPRESENTATION ON THE CONGREGATION BOARD OF TRUSTEES
- 1931 GREAT DEPRESSION PUT SISTERHOOD INTO DEBT. DUES WAS NOT ENOUGH AS WE STRUGGLED TO HELP THE CONGREGATION SURVIVE. FUEL BILLS AND SALARIES WERE OFTEN UNPAID.
- 1936 THE FLOOD----AND THE DANCE HAD TO BE CANCELLED, BUT WAS RE-SCHEDULED AND THE PROCEEDS TURNED OVER TO THE CITY OF PITTSBURGH FLOOD RELIEF.
- MID-1930 HEBREW SCHOOL MOVED TO FORBES AVENUE NEAR SHADY. BECAME THE FIRST PROGRESSIVE HEBREW SCHOOL IN PITTSBURGH BECAUSE CLASSES WERE HELD THREE DAYS A WEEK. SISTERHOOD EQUIPPED THE BUILDING WITH MODERN FURNITURE.
 - 1937 SISTERHOOD HELD THE FIRST GIFT LUNCHEON----TODAY'S DONOR
 - 1940 THANKSGIVING EVE DANCES BEGAN----HAPPY DAY FUND CREATED WHICH IS TODAY'S REMEMBRANCE FUND
 - 1941 DECEMBER 7----A TRAGIC DAY----SISTERHOOD CONCENTRATED ALL EFFORTS ON WAR RELIEF. SOLD STAMPS AND WAR BONDS AT A SISTERHOOD BOND BRUNCH AND RAISED \$15,000.00----RECEIVED A CITATION FROM THE U.S. TREASURY DEPARTMENT. WE DID OUR PART BY ROLLING BANDAGES AND KNITTING FOR THE RED CROSS.
 - 1947 DECESION TO CONSTRUCT A NEW BUILDING AT WILKINS AND SHADY AVENUES. SISTERHOOD PLEDGED \$35,000.00, ONE OF MANY. PRESENTLY WE ARE PAYING ON OUR 8TH PLEDGE OF \$50,000,00 AND HAVE MET OUR OBLIGATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$335,000.00.
