The proposed new Center will consist of three stories which will house the Hebrew School, social hall, auditorium, etc., making it in fact a center where not only the activities of the older Jewry may be carried on but where the Jewish youth of the Tri-Boroughs may carry on their activities in a true Jewish atmosphere.

In order that the members of these communities may be fully acquainted with the progress which the Executive Committee is making, a general meeting has been called for Wednesday evening, July 7th, at 8 o'clock, and will be held in the Moose Temple, 522 Braddock Avenue, Braddock. To lend additional interest for both the older and younger members of the community, Alexander Cooper, Esq., Professor in the English Department of the University of Pittsburgh, has been secured to deliver an address that evening. Prof. Cooper has been heard innumerable times in Pittsburgh and surrounding towns and his message will undoubtedly contain much worthwhile substance. M. Kostman, chairman of the Executive Committee of the Center, will preside.

In order that the erection of the new Center may proceed without any halt, the cooperation of every member of the Jewish communities of Braddock, North Braddock, Rankin and Swissvale is urged and attendance at the meeting on July 7th will be deeply appreciated by those men who are working so unsparingly that the future of the youth of these communities may be in accordance with the truest Jewish tradition.
