"No vinous, malt, brewed, or spirituous liquors of any kind whatsoever, shall be sold or kept for sale or used, served or distributed in connection with this corporation, or in any room or rooms in which meetings are held, or any of its business transacted, except after full and complete compliance with the liquor laws of the State of Pennsylvania, the Constitution of the United States, and any other law or laws, local, State or National, which may regulate and control the sale and distribution of liquor."

AND be it further resolved that the officers of this Tuscan League proceed for the purpose of securing an amendment to the original Articles of Incorporation, as hereinbefore set forth, and the Secretary and President of this club are hereby duly authorized to execute any Affidavits, Petitions, forms, or papers, and to affix the seal of the corporation to any such papers for the purpose of obtaining this amendment.
