TO THE HONORABLE the Judges of said Court:

In compliance with the requirements of an Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania entitled "An Act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain corporations" approved the 29th. day of April A.D. 1874 and the several supplements thereto, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the State of Pennsylvania and of the United States of America, have associated themselves for the purpose hereinafter specified, and desire that they may be incorporated and that a Charter may be issued to them and to their successors according to law, do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of the proposed corporation is "Congregation Shaare Zion".

SECOND: The corporation is formed for the purpose of conducting public religious worship according to the established usages, customs and precepts of Orthodox Judaism; to maintain a place of worship and to teach, study and uphold the Hebraic religion together with the principles of Zionism.

THIRD: The expense of maintaining and carrying out the foregoing purpose of the corporation is to be paid from a fund created by the payment of initiation fees, dues and assessments by the members and from such other sources as may from time to time be expedient.

This provision, as well as that relating to eligibility to membership in this corporation, are to be under such terms and regulations as shall be established by the Constitution and By-Laws which are to be adopted immediately after the granting of this Charter and to be consistent with the provisions thereof and with the Constitution of the State of Pennsylvania, and that of the United States of America.

FOURTH: The place where the business of the proposed corporation is to be transacted is in the City of Pittsburgh, County of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania.

FIFTH: The corporation shall have perpetual succession by its corporate name.

TENTH: All property, real or personal, of the said corporation shall be taken, held and inure subject to the control and disposition of the lay members thereof or such constituted officers or representatives as shall be composed of a majority of lay members, citizens of Pennsylvania, having a controlling power according to the rules, regulations, usages or corporate requirements thereof.
