

NER SHEL YOM HAZIKORON








with the TWO appropriate blessings*












from approximately the age of 3

Special Instructions for Saturday
On holidays it is forbidden to create new
fire by striking a match, etc. Therefore one
should light the candles from a pre-existing
flame i.e. pilot light, gas or candle flame
