The Israel Emergency Fund is \$47.40 richer because of the efforts of three Squirrel Hill young people.

Prior to the carnival these amateur promoters rummaged through their basements and sought donations from local businesses for prizes for the carnival. They constructed homemade signs and leaflets which they distributed in the neighborhood for publicity.
